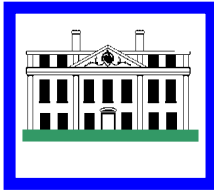

Family Yoga Club

On Mondays from 3.30pm-4.15pm Mrs Tyler, a TA from Aslacton school, will be coming to Manor Field to run a Family Yoga Club. Yoga has proved very popular with the younger children at Aslacton and is a great way to teach them techniques for relaxing and building muscle strength. We are able to offer this to 12 family groups, from all year groups (only one adult per family group please) and younger siblings may also attend. Adults will be taking part in the activities alongside their children, and everyone must be appropriately dressed in P.E appropriate clothing, with hair tied up and all jewellery removed. We will provide mats, however if you have your own you are welcome to bring them with you. You will need to collect your child from their class at the end of the day and make your way to the hall where your child can change into their kit. (You must remain with your child).
