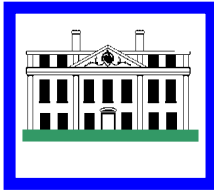

Ruby-For her excellent call and response, singing to African music.

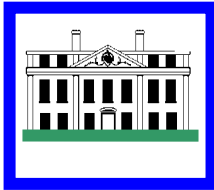
Lucas-For great singing and dancing when learning an African call and response song.
