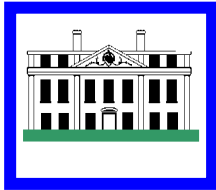

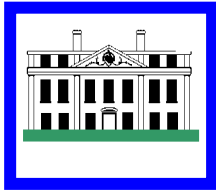

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Scooters/Bikes

Can we please remind parents that scooters and bikes of any description must NOT be ridden on the playgrounds. Please dismount and walk across the playgrounds and use the bike shed facility on site.

E-Scooters/Electric Scooters

Please see below the guidance from Norfolk Constabulary regarding the use of any form of electric scooters

Privately owned e-scooters are only legal to use on private land. You cannot get insurance to ride these in public spaces. This means they CANNOT be ridden on roads, pavements or any public space.

Please refrain from bringing any electric powered scooters or hover boards onto the school site. Many thanks for your co-operation.
