We are receiving a lot of holiday request forms during term time. Can we please remind parents that we are unable to authorise any holidays in term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

The Local Authority operates a system where any pupil will meet the criteria for legal intervention where they have:

- At least 9 sessions (4.5 school days) lost to unauthorised absence during the last 6 school weeks.

The intervention could be in the form of a fixed penalty notice. Any pupil at Manor Field Infant & Nursery School who meets the criteria will be referred to the Local Authority for action to be considered.
